## IN MEMORIAM



**Frederick F. Reed**  
*Class of 1946*  
1929 – 2011

Thursday December 22, 2011 marked the passing of Frederick F. "Fritz" Reed, the 90th President of the Shamokin Area High School Alumni Association. Fritz was a 1946 graduate of Shamokin High School, as well as Lycoming College. As a young man, he was the vice president and manager of Reeds Milk and Ice Cream Company. He later went on to become the mayor of the City of Shamokin and retired as the Northumberland County Register of Wills and Recorder of Deeds. An avid historian, Fritz was a member of the Northumberland County Historical Society and Warrior Run-Fort Freeland Heritage Society. Fritz was a life member of the Rescue Fire Company, a Manna for the Many board member, and a member of the Bear Gap Shipwreck Club. He also served as past president of the Greater Shamokin Chamber of Commerce, Shamokin Area Jaycees and two Parent-Teacher Organizations. Fritz served the class of 1946 as its president for 55 years and was most recently the Vice-President of the Education Fund.
