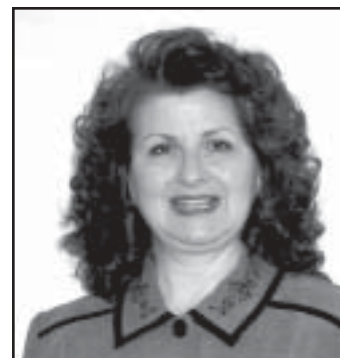
## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

# SECRETARY'S REPORT

Minutes - May 27, 2006  
Meeting/Banquet

The Shamokin Area High School Alumni Association's 123rd annual reunion was held on May 27th at Masser's Banquet Hall in Paxinos, PA. A total of 267 were present. Books from the 25th, 50th, 75th and 100th anniversaries were on display along with books containing names of contributors over the years to the general and educational century clubs. The Banquet began with President John Klinger '68 welcoming everyone to the festivities. The invocation was given by Rev. James Williams '56 followed by the pledge to the flag and signing of "God Bless America."

Upon completion of dinner, the business meeting commenced with President John Klinger asking all Veterans to stand and be recognized. President Klinger then asked all to stand for a moment of silence for military veterans. A motion to accept the annual secretary and treasurer report as written in the bulletin was given by Shirley Fisher Jackson '51 and second by Garth Hall '56. All were in favor.

The class of 2006 presented their pennant and the class was recognized. Presenting the pennant were Nathan Schwalm, Dustin Venn, and Sara Coulbourn.

Bonnie Klinger introduced a barbershop quartet from Shamokin Area Junior-Senior High school. Members of the quartet were Meredith Szymanski, Emily Hollick, Wendy Jaeger and Amber Carnuccio. Bonnie Klinger recognized Jim Krebs '56 for his outstanding dedication to the quartet as their coach.

Garth Hall was commended for his dedication and time spent selling miniature wooden replicas of historical buildings symbolizing the Shamokin area. Through his efforts over \$11,000 has been donated to the scholarship fund.

Door prizes were presented by Mary Anne (Pitorak) Miller and Susan Kropinski with the assistance from member of the current senior class. A total of 46 door prizes were awarded.

Vice President Mary Anne (Pitorak) Miller recognized the anniversary classes and informed

the alumni and guests that \$110,000 will be going out in scholarships.

Class of 1975 - a letter was read and a check was presented in the sum of \$314.99.

Class of 1956 - Winifred Glinck Nemecek presented \$7000 to the Educational School Fund. Class member Jim Latsha presented \$4,356 to the general fund. The amount of \$1,956 was contributed to the Richard Hilbush Fund. In addition, Joanne (Yarworth) Krebs presented \$2,500 donated by William Garth Hall is to be used to establish a Memorial Fund in the name of Sara Wiest Hall. The total contribution was \$13,312.

Class of 1931 - Celebrating their Diamond Anniversary were asked to stand and be recognized; five members were in attendance.

The Distance Award was given to Sandy Herb '56 who is from Arizona.

The golden anniversary class members were asked to stand and be recognized. A gift was presented to each member present.
