Minutes/Summary May 24, 2008

The Shamokin Area High School Alumni Association's 125th (1883- 2008) anniversary reunion was held on Saturday May 24th at the Elysburg Fire Company, Elysburg, Pennsylvania. The Banquet began with President Barry "Mike" Buriak '62 welcoming everyone to the festivities and thanking everyone that helped with this year's banquet and those that helped with previous banquets. Mike explained the program had been changed to have all the scholarship winners go to the Coal Township Alumni Banquet to be recognized. Plans were altered after it was decided it would be too much of an inconvenience for the students. A committee would be meeting between the two Alumni Associations to discuss future banquets sometime soon. The Reverend Susan Roehs of Clark's Grove United Methodist Church gave the invocation. President Buriak then introduced the head table and officers. The Pledge of Allegiance to the flag was followed by the singing of "God Bless America" accompanied by Vic Boris '66 and his band the Sound Expression.

Musical numbers were presented by the senior chorus accompanied by Bonny Ensinger Klinger '68. Members of the chorus were Kevin Hopper, Eliza Reed, Christie Blair, Ardella Dobson, Nate Ford, Samantha Hager, and Caitlin Collier. They performed the songs; "Irish Blessing" and "Coming Home".

President Buriak asked the class of 2008 to stand and be recognized. He wished them all the best and Good Luck in their future endeavors. Jessica Dascani, President of the Senior Class, presented President Buriak with the class pennant and said, "Thank you, for all you do for us."

John Klinger '68 had the Shamokin Valedictorian/Salutatorian plaque on display at the banquet, several years still needed to be filled in. A similar plaque was on display at the Coal Township Alumni banquet. Sam Weaver Coal Township '65 found all names of Coal Township High School winners from 1900 to 1965, the year of the jointure between the two schools. Tommy Ryan and Jeff Clutcher '78 were also recognized for all their hard work in researching Shamokin winners. Irvin Liachowitz '42 designed and engraved all the names for both plaques. The plaques were presented at a special ceremony at the Shamokin Area High School on May 20th, 2008 and would be permanently on display in the lobby. John Klinger thanked the Shamokin Alumni Association for their help and financial support for this special project.

Irvin Liachowitz '42 of the education trust committee announced the winners of the alumni scholarship testing. The scholarships are for each of four years of college. Fourteen awards were given ranging from \$800.00 to \$3000.00 from the Coal Township Alumni and the Shamokin Alumni Associations. A complete list of names can be seen on Page 3.

A motion was carried to accept both the secretary and treasurer reports.

Vice President Susan Salvatore Reed '78 recognized the anniversary classes. Class of 1938 was celebrating their 70th class reunion. There were 10 members present and the class donated \$1121.00 to the General Fund.

Sara Lewis Neidig Zerby read a poem in honor of the Class of 1943 celebrating their 65th anniversary. Four members were present and the class gave a gift of \$1581.00 to the General Fund.

The class of 1948 has 23 active members who get together regularly for picnics and pig roasts. The 60th anniversary class donated \$2020.00 to the General Fund and \$200.00 to the Scholarship Fund.

The class of 1953 being represented by John Schankweiler donated \$5300.00 with matching funds totaling \$7000.00 to the General Fund and \$53.00 to the H. Richard Hillbush Scholarship Fund.

The Class of 1956, represented by Winifred J. Nemecek, gave a special donation of \$195.00 to the General Fund to cover the mailings and postage expenses incurred for the banquet.

The classes of 1963; 1973; 1983(silver anniversary); 1988; 1993; 1998; 2003 were recognized.

John Klinger challenged his 40th anniversary class of 1968 to raise funds for the Scholarship and General Funds when they meet later this year. A check will be sent to the Association at that time.

Class of 1978 representative Jeffrey Clutcher announced their class reunion would be held at Indian Hills Golf Club in July.

The Golden Anniversary Class of '58 had 20 members, of the 75 active members in attendance. Each received a coal memento with their anniversary on it. Their representative thanked the banquet committee. The golden anniversary class donated \$16,800.00 with a few class members still looking to donate to the Scholarship Fund. Also a 1958 alumnus and his wife donated a special \$1000.00 scholarship award to a student attending Penn State's main campus and \$100.00 for one attending a branch campus in the fall in memory of his parents,

Maurice and Florence Harrison. These awards have been donated by Bob Harrison, Shamokin High - Class of 1958 and Penn State - Class of 1962 and his wife, Terri Harrison.

The long distance award went to Barbara Goldberg Geisman class of 1958 who traveled from Israel to attend this year's anniversary.

Bill Korbich thanked everyone who contributed a total of over \$27,072.00 plus \$195.60 for postage and matching funds donated this year.

Mr. Chris Venna, high school principal, warmly thanked the Alumni Association for all their support and generosity. The efforts of the Alumni Association greatly help the school district and, even more importantly, help the students by affording them opportunities that otherwise may not have been possible. Mr. Venna provided an extensive list of academic, musical and sports activities at the high school.

The ratification of three trustees to the education committee was conducted by Joan Fauland Eltringham '59, Trustee committee president; David Donmoyer '48, Attorney H. Robert Mattis '68 and Attorney David Marateck '72. Myron Moskowitz '42 made a motion to accept the nominees. John Klinger '68 seconded the motion. The motion was carried. Nominations for the education committee officers are as follows; Joan Fauland Eltringham '59 president; John Schankweiler '53 vice president; William Korbich '54 treasurer and Frances Brennan '63 secretary. Jeffrey Clutcher '78 made a motion to accept the nominees and Alma Carl seconded the motion. The motion was carried.

Nominations for alumni association officers were presented by Mike Buriak '62. On the vote, the new slate was accepted.

Susan Salvatore Reed '78, President; James Backes '79, Vice-P resident; William Korbich '54, Treasurer; Dorene M. Weaver Choffel '77, Secretary; Helen Jane Murphy '43, Historian; Jeffrey Clutcher '78, Registrar.

President Buriak congratulated the slate and introduced the new president and vice-president to those present. After the business meeting concluded with the singing of the Alma Mater, the old and the new versions, and the benediction everyone was invited to remain for the Afterglow festivities. Music was provided by Vic Boris ('66) Sound Expression. A buffet was also served.

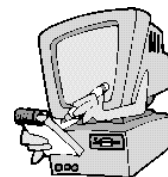
