We do not know how many alumni attended this affair, but at that time the organization consisted of only 35 graduates. This year we, as that organization which has evolved into the Shamokin Area High School Alumni Association with over 11,600 members, will hold our annual reunion for the 129th consecutive time. It is my honor as this year's President, to invite each and every one of you to attend that gathering on May 26, 2012.

Our reunion has come to be a time we when cherish the past, take pride in the present, and pass on the torch to those who will lead our organization into the future.

We cherish the past by rekindling the special memories of that formative period when we advanced from adolescence to the verge of adulthood.
