

Accelerated Reader

Accelerated Reader is an academic program that promotes and encourages reading. In the Accelerated Reader program a point value is assigned for each book and an allotted amount of points can be earned by taking a multiple choice computergenerated test on the book(s) that have been read.

Grading for Accelerated Reader:

Accumulated A.R. points from taking the computerized tests count for **one**, **100 point test** grade per marking period.

*** Students will earn 5 bonus points for every additional point they earn in a marking period beyond 20. **Example:** A student earning 22 points would earn 10 bonus points (2 x 5= 10). Students *may earn up to 50 bonus points* in this category per marking period.

*** Notes

- Points earned are scaled to the number of **CORRECT** questions a student answers. **Example:** If a book is worth 10 points, and contains 10 questions a student answering 9 questions correct would earn 9 points, not 10.
- Students **MUST** take the AR quiz in front of the classroom teacher.
