Tips for Participating

- Prepare for class (preview the material)
- Relax and speak up! We want to hear from you.
- Reflect on our content and share your reflection
- Can you relate our content to something today in current events or in your life?
- Can you notice problems and/or solutions in regards to the discussed the ideas, actors, andr events?
- What questions can you come up with to ask the teacher or another student?
- What do you not understand?
- Discuss and debates ideas, actors, and events.
- What conclusions can you draw?
- Explain why?
- Would you do something different?
- Observe and imitate what other student participation looks like
- If you are not sure, ask!
- Question the evidence!
- Why is this important?
- What can you learn from this?
- What are the impacts?
- What do you think--really though, tell us?
- What is the cause/effect relationship
- Are there any different view points?
- What are the significant issues?
- Reflect on morals, empathy, and justice
- Reflect on what is right and what is wrong
