gies to keep our association vibrant and prospering and making this banquet a huge success. I extend to each of you my most deepest sincere thanks and appreciation.

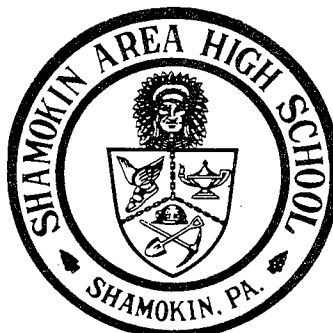
May the fellowship and inspiration of this banquet be as enjoyable and invigorating to you as it is to me.
