

Donald J. Cowling Speaker  
For the Annual Banquet

Dr. Donald J. Cowling started his early school days in and near Shamokin. His father was pastor of the local United Brethren Church for a number of years, and, during this time, the speaker of the evening attended the Shamokin schools. If he had remained here, to the end of his high school course, he would have graduated with the class of 1899; accordingly, the 50-year class considers Dr. Cowling one of its members.

After leaving Shamokin, Dr. Cowling graduated from Lebanon Valley College at Annville, did graduate work at Yale University, was a teacher at Baker University at Baldwin, Kansas, and from July 1, 1909, to September 1, 1945, he served as president of Carleton College, one of the outstanding schools of the Middle West.

In 1918, he was decorated by the French government with the title of "Officer of Public Instruction" for outstanding work accomplished in the exchange of students between the United States and France. For 10 years he was chairman of the board of advisors of the National Student Federation of America. He has served with distinction on the committee of the United States upon the visit of the British Educational Mission to this country. He is a member of the executive committee of the League to Enforce Peace, New York and he is also a member of the League of Nations Association, New York, and has served upon various educational and religious boards of his own state, of his country and various international committees and councils of education.

Dr. Cowling has traveled extensively, having visited most of the countries of Europe and also Egypt, Palestine and Turkey. Prior to the second World War, he went to Russia as a member of the educational commission of which Professor John Dewey of Columbia University was a chairman.

Dr. Cowling is a member of Phi Beta Kappa and of Sigma Xi. He holds membership in various scholastic and professional societies, including the American Psychological Association and the American Philosophical Association. He has published various magazine articles and addresses on educational and religious subjects and is the author (with President Carter Davidson, Union College, Schenectady, New York) of a volume on COLLEGES FOR FREEDOM (Harper & Brothers, November, 1947). Dr. Cowling has four degrees from Yale University—A. B., M. A., B.D., and Ph. D. He has received honorary degrees from many institutions, including the degree of LL.D. from Williams and Oberlin Colleges and the University of Minnesota.

His career is summarized in "Who's Who."
