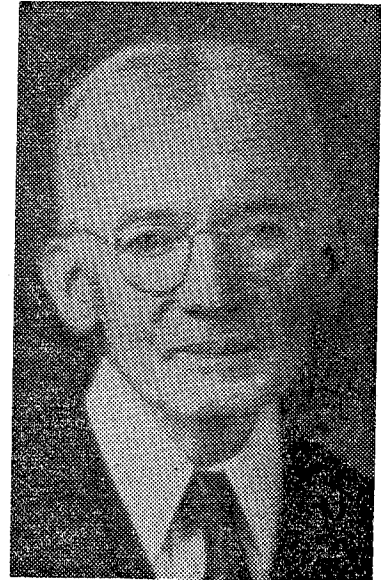

The officers of the Shamokin High School Alumni Association extend their best wishes to W. J. Wiest who probably has done more than any living individual to keep the flame of this association's life blazing fiercely.

Mr. Wiest was the valedictorian of the class of 1894 and one of the early members of the association. He served as its president in 1909 after having served as historian in 1908. In 1914 he was elected treasurer of the association and continued in that capacity until he voluntarily retired in 1913. On May 28, 1947, the association elected him honorary president for life.

Members of the association will remember the splendid history of its organization and growth which Mr. Wiest wrote for the fiftieth anniversary celebration in 1933. Fewer remember a similar history he wrote for the twenty-fifth anniversary in 1908. Scarcely any will know until they read this that he has already written the preface for the seventy-fifth anniversary history to be published in 1958.

Mr. Wiest has maintained his interest in the Shamokin schools since his graduation in 1894 and from 1919 to 1931 he served as a member of the Shamokin Borough school board. He has been indefatigable in his interest in the affairs of this association and your association's directing officers wish to make public acknowledgment of their gratitude for his willingness to cooperate and his wise counsel.

The treasurer's report (May 19, 1885) showed liabilities in excess of assets of 60 cents. The following amendment to the Constitution was then adopted. Amendment 1, Section 1, when the dues of any member amounts to one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50), he or she shall be liable to expulsion at the discretion of the president.

Well this is 1950, sixty-five years later—and the amendment is still part of the Constitution and By-Laws of this association and the annual dues are still only 25 cents.

Is there any reason, outside of sheer neglect or indifference, why any member should not send in the annual dues?
