Greetings:

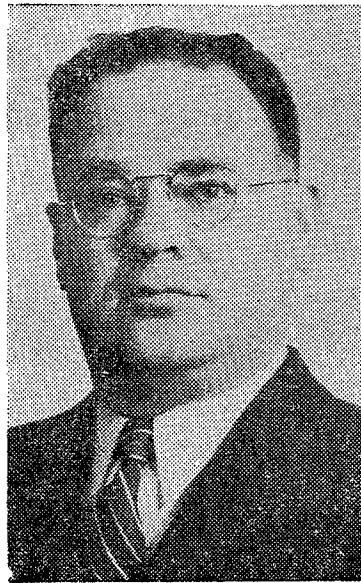

THE TREASURER'S CORNER

DUES

This past year approximately 2,000 members paid their current and delinquent dues. Sad to relate 3,700 members did NOT pay ANY dues. This indifference or carelessness on the part of members of this association is hard to explain. Certainly it cannot be the lack of twenty-five cents. Perhaps you feel, "Well, they won't miss my quarter." But, 3,700 quarters are \$900.00 plus, and we could do a lot of things with \$900.00 which we cannot do now.

SCHOLARSHIP FUND

As you will note elsewhere this fund has now reached \$29,813.94. From May 17, 1922, when it was started till June, 1930, the fund grew to \$3,737.00. In the next 12 years \$1,475.00 was added. Then the Fund really struck oil. In the past 9 years with the rivalry of the anniversary classes and the splendid cooperation of the members of the Century Club who have subscribed almost ten thousand dollars to the total, another \$23,000 was added. This past year the Executive Committee voted to give the winner of the Scholarship award \$150.00 a year for a period of 4 years or a total of \$600.00 to further their education. Now, 1958, the year of the Association Diamond Jubilee is five years away. Wouldn't that be a timely and auspicious occasion to announce that the winner of the award would receive \$1,000.00 or \$250.00 a year over a 4-year period. Well, the fund will only need ten thousand more dollars or an average of \$2,000.00 per year in order to achieve it. Let's do it!

And now a valedictory speech. With the celebration of the 70th Reunion, the writer will conclude his tenth and final year as your association treasurer. Business and personal activities will no longer permit me to give the time to the duties of this office. I know you will give my successor the same fine cooperation you have always given me. Again, let me say, "Thank You."
