SHS Alumni Plans Scholarship Test

An examination to determine the winners of the 1959 scholarships sponsored annually by the Shamokin High School Alumni Association will be conducted among 29 senior students on Saturday, April 4.

Members of the scholarship committee reported that the procedure for this year's testing program has been somewhat changed in that the examinations will be given Saturday instead of during a school day.

In keeping with a policy of previous years, the alumni will present two scholarships to members of the 1959 graduating class. A scholarship in the amount of \$800, given in sums of \$200 over a four year period, will be awarded to the student attaining the top grade in the forthcoming examination. The runner-up, or student posting the second highest grade, will be presented \$100 for four years. Amounts must be applied to college education at an institution of the student's choice.

Twenty-nine senior students of the local high school have been registered to take the examination, scheduled to begin at 8:30 Saturday morning in the high school. The examination will be under the supervision of Harold Thomas, high school guidance director, and will consist of American history, phases of English as well as a comprehensive test.

As in previous years, the names of the winner and runner-up will not be known until a sealed envelope is opened during the alumni's annual banquet and reunion program. This year's reunion is scheduled for Saturday, May 23, in the high school annex.

The alumni scholarship committee is headed by Robert M. Thomas and Mollie J. Payne, chairman and vice-chairman, respectively. Other members of the committee are John Phillips, secretary; John F. Gillespie, Herbert H. Zaring, Harry Strine, J. Ferdinand McConnell, W. Francis Grow, Ruth S. Lark, J. Nevin Aucker, J. Herbert Lawrence, H. Wilson Lark, and Robert Mattern.
