Formerly Alumni Bulletins were mailed under the Bulk Rate Class and, if bearing an incorrect address, were not forwarded to the addressee even if such was on file at the receiving Post Office. Instead, all were returned to the sender either bearing the forwarding address or the notation "Left No Address" or "Unknown." Last year 814 with new addresses provided and 65 of the "Unknown" order were returned at a cost \$85.00, which means that 879 members received no notice of that years' reunion or information about our Association.

Under new postal regulations, effective January 7, the Bulk Rate has been discontinued and Bulletins are being mailed at a higher cost — the First Class Rate. If incorrectly addressed each will be forwarded by the receiving Post Office, provided a new one has been filed. A copy will also be returned to the Association at 10 cents each. If we should again experience the same results as last year, the expense will be greater than in 1967.
