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New Shamokin Area Senior High School

The new senior high school will be located on the hillside south of Kemp Memorial Stadium.

The building is designed to hold 1,429 students in grades 9-10-11-12, and has several distinctive features. Among them a Natatorium containing an Olympic size swimming pool with six lanes and a seating area for spectators holding 200 persons. The building also features a television studio for live telecasts; a green house associated with science classes; an observatory and one classroom containing a planetarium with a dome-shaped ceiling for the projection of space related media.

The gymnasium consists of a main floor and two small remedial gyms having a total seating capacity for 3,000 people.

The auditorium which has a total seating capacity of 1,200-1,250, features an over-size stage and a balcony which can be divided for large/small group instruction.

Since the building has a total of four floors, there will be a service elevator, which also can be used for the handicapped or in case of emergencies.

Probably the most significant feature of all is the design of movable/removable type partitions allowing for flexibility in determining the size and space needed for any classroom activity. The present philosophy of the school being that students learn best under the concept of independent study fortified by individualized instruction. The construction of the new school provides for all of this.

I am sure that we agree that the new high school will contribute to upgrading our school system through a modern facility designed and staffed to provide the best possible type of educational program for our young citizens.

The building is completely air-conditioned and heated by electricity.

Cost—\$9,000,000.
