The ninety-first Shamokin Area High School Alumni Association Annual Reunion convened at 7:00 o'clock P.M. on Saturday, May 25, 1974, in the Shamokin Area High School Annex with approximately five hundred members and guests present.

The invocation was given by The Reverend Mr. Alfred Bashore followed by the singing of "America" and the Pledge of Allegiance to our Flag.

President James Booth extended a Welcome to everyone and introduced the guests at the speaker's table.

Following a delicious dinner served by Ghezzi's Catering Service, President Booth opened the business meeting. He stated that the secretary's minutes and the treasurer's report had been published in the invitation, therefore, everyone had already read them. As there were no objections to either report, they were accepted as published.

Vice President Elizabeth Ryan recognized the following decennial classes: Class of 1914, represented by Chester Haas had sixteen members present. Mr. Haas stated that he had attended sixty reunions and another member of the class, Mrs. Marian Woolcock Rumberger attended fifty-nine reunions. Class of 1934 represented by George Shroyer; class of 1954 represented by Harry Strausser, Silver Anniversary class represented by Mrs. Jeanne Wary Klinger. The Golden Anniversary class represented by Frederick Bright announced they had worked for a goal of \$2,400.00 for their alumni gift and the amount was exceeded by \$1,100.00. The additional amount is to be used to present a \$100.00 gift to the fifth honor student of each graduation class for eleven years. Contributions to the scholarship fund totaled \$4,500.00. Gifts were then presented to seventy-seven members of the fifty-year class.

President Booth recognized the thirty-five year class, 1939, the for-

ty-five year class, 1929, and the five year class, 1969. Classes of 1911, 1912 and 1913 had members present.

The election of officers by the executive committee was ratified. They are President, Miss Elizabeth G. Ryan; Vice President, Paul G. Ruane and Historian, Frances L. Rowe each for a one year term. The following were elected for two years, Treasurer, John Phillips; Secretary, Mrs. Mollie Jeremiah Payne, and Registrar, Aubrey Phillips.

John M. Phillips, Treasurer presented the annual scholarship awards: First award of \$450.00 each year for four years to Daniel O'Day, second award of \$375.00 to Joseph Weikel, third award by Coal Township Alumni Association \$300.00 to George Shaloka and fourth award by Shamokin Area High School Alumni Association \$300.00 to Lora Dick.

President Booth declared the business meeting adjourned and announced that the entertainment for the evening would be the Black Diamond Chapter of Sweet Adelines, Inc. under the direction of our music chairman, James A. Krebs. The program was excellent and enjoyed by all.

The ninety-first reunion closed by the singing of the Alma Mater followed by benediction given by Pastor Bashore.

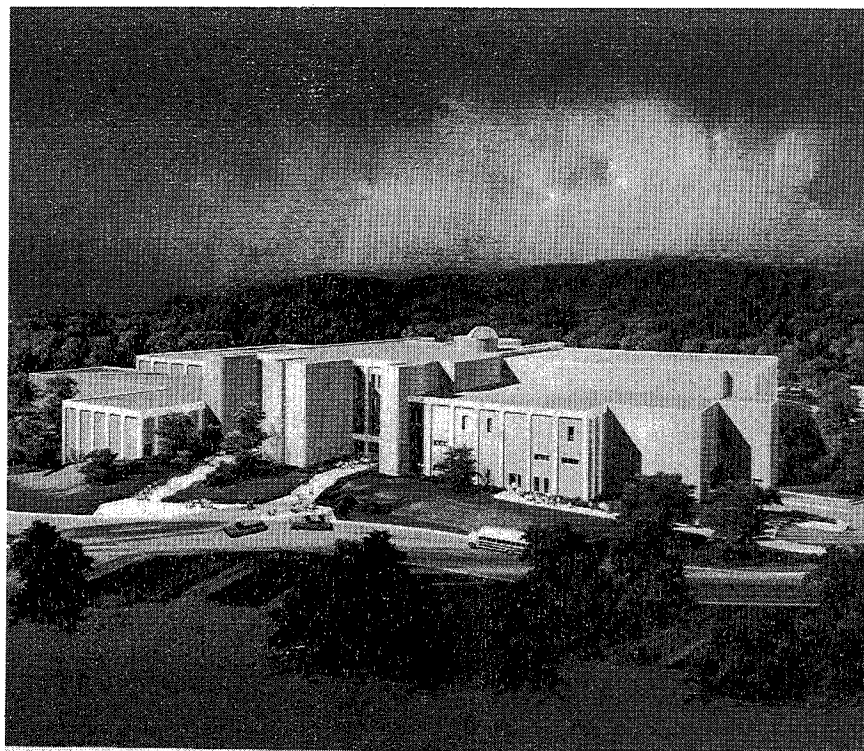
