Alumni Notes

Saturday, May 27, 1978

The ninety-fifth reunion of the Shamokin Area High School Alumni Association was held in the annex on Saturday, May 27, 1978 at 6:30 P.M.

The reunion was opened with the invocation by the Rev. George M. Mark, pastor of the Christian & Missionary Alliance Church, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Over 400 Alumni members and guests were welcomed by President Harry Strausser, Jr.

Following a delicious beef dinner served by Lewis Gaydon, a member of the Alumni Association, President Strausser opened the business meeting by introducing the officers and guests at the head table. As the secretary's and treasurer's reports were published in the invitations sent out, the reading of the reports were dispensed with. As there were no objections, the reports were accepted.

Silent prayer was offered as a memorial for the deceased members.

President Strausser introduced the Class of 1978. Melissa A. McElwee, class president, responded with the presentation of their class pennant.

Recognition of the decennial classes was under the direction of Ruth Shroyer Lark, Vice President. They included, Class of 1908, Miss Susan Beard; 1918, John Prosser; 1938, Bernard Pufnock; 1948, James Booth; 1958, Robert Harrison; 1953, Silver Anniversary Class, John Schankweiler, and the 1928, Golden Anniversary Class, William F. Dyer. Contributions to the scholarship and general funds were presented by the classes. Gifts were presented to the Fifty Year

Class members on behalf of the Alumni Association.

The plaque for traveling the greatest distance was presented by Mrs. Ruth Lark to Mrs. Margaret Beach Baxley, who journeyed from San Francisco, California.

Past Presidents of the association in attendance were given recognition by President Strausser.
