and began his full-time work on November 1.

Dr. Johnston was elected to fill the vacancy created when Dr. Daniel Witmer resigned late last summer after serving just one year in the superintendent post. George Edwards, district business manager, served as acting superintendent in the interim between the departure of Dr. Witmer and the arrival of Dr. Johnston.

James Johnston, who taught in grades 7 to 12 while serving as a teacher in schools of the Pittsburgh region, was graduated from South Hills High School in 1945. He served in the military during World War II and then entered the University of Pittsburgh, from which he was graduated in 1951 with a bachelor of science degree in biology.

Johnston earned a master of education degree at Pitt in 1957 and received a doctor of education degree from the same institution in 1969.

Prior to coming to Shamokin, Dr. Johnston worked in school districts of the Pittsburgh area. After starting his career in the Pittsburgh School District, he served for five years as superintendent of public schools in Duquesne, Pa., and then was superintendent in the California Area School District, located in western Pennsylvania.

Dr. Johnston was elected after he was named as one of several qualified candidates for the superintendency by Dr. William Caldwell, Penn State consultant hired by the school board to screen applicants for the post.

Assisting in selection of the new superintendent was a citizen panel which included Thomas Olcese, Paul Zarick and Donald Myers. Others who aided in the task of choosing a superintendent were Mary Miller, teacher representative, and Edward Binkoskie, assistant high school principal, administration representative.

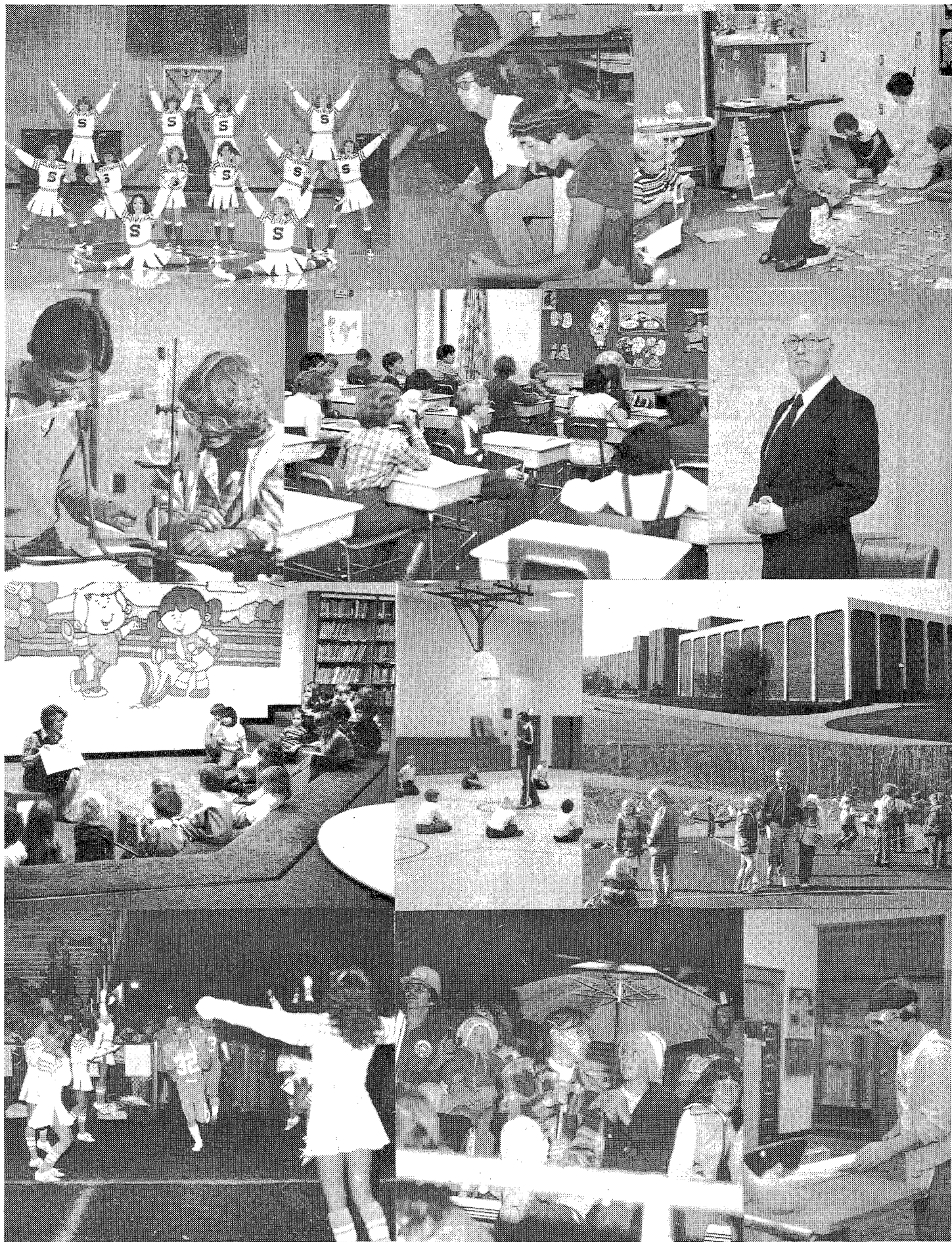

Student Loans

During the period of time that the Revolving Loan Fund was in operation, many students of the high school borrowed money from the fund.
