


President's Message

Alumni Celebrates Centennial In 1983

Looking toward the observance of our 100th anniversary in 1983, members of Shamokin Area High School Alumni Association can take great pride in the accomplishments of the organization, without question one that is unique in the nation.

It all started May 2, 1884, when 14 persons met in a private home to organize an association of Shamokin High School graduates. The first annual reunion was held May 7, 1884, with 28 persons present. By-Laws were adopted during a meeting on September 8 of that year, with the objective of the organization stated to be "to strengthen the kind feelings and maintain the friendships which bind together the graduates of Shamokin High School and to perpetuate the memories of our Alma Mater."

From that humble beginning, when 23 graduates paid 25 cents each as an initiation fee, Shamokin Area High School Alumni Association has grown to more than 10,000. While the number changes daily through losses caused by death, the total number of Alumni notices mailed every year has hovered at the 10,000 mark for many years.

Inspired leaders of Shamokin High School Alumni Association started an outstanding service to the cause of education when they established a Scholarship Fund in 1922 to provide financial assistance for the first honor student in the pursuit of higher education. The fund balance of slightly less than \$4,000 was deposited in 1931 in a new account, "Shamokin High School Alumni Scholarship Trust Fund."

Small scholarships were provided for one student each year until 1954, when the number each year was increased to two awards. Over the years since then the annual scholarship presentations increased in size and number and today there are five awards given annually.

With more than \$215,000 in the Scholarship Trust Fund, Alumni leaders look to the time when the fund will pass the quarter-million dollar mark. From a small beginning, when it was fed with revenue from food sales, plays, dances, etc., the Scholarship Fund has grown in the last 30 years at rapid pace, principally through contributions by classes and individuals. A big factor in the development of giving by individuals was the establishment of the Century

Club, which has as its members those who have contributed \$100 or more to the Scholarship Fund.

John M. Phillips, long-time treasurer of our association, reports that some records are missing, making an accurate count impossible, but well over 100 students have been recipients of Shamokin High School Alumni Scholarships. He estimates, too, that the total of the awards since the fund was established exceeds \$100,000. Phillips pointed out that scholarships in the 1980-81 school year totaled \$18,000 and in the 1981-82 term the total rose to \$22,000. The amount awarded each year depends on the earnings of the trust fund.

Shamokin High School Alumni Association has served as a vehicle for the renewing of friendships and for acceding recognition to achievers. The association is now represented in every state in the union and in a large number of foreign countries. Among those graduates are many who have earned outstanding success in their chosen fields, and it is a favored conclusion of Shamokin High School graduates that any success in any endeavor was inspired, at least in part, by the time spent in Shamokin High.

There are many alumni achievements to boast about...some by the Alumni as an organization and many more by individual members. All of these matters will be reviewed in myriad ways when the grads convene in 1983. YOU should start planning now—to take part in the big 100th anniversary reunion next year.
