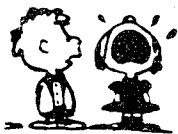

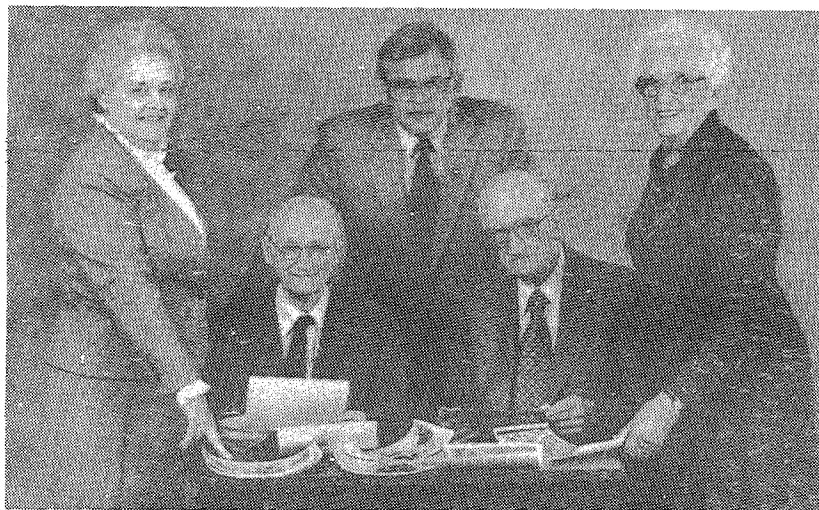

SCHOLARSHIP NEWS

THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

Winners of scholarships are determined through competitive examinations which are prepared by National testing organizations. Each paper bears an identifying number only. A sealed envelope containing names and numbers of contestants is entrusted to the alumni treasurer who breaks the seal in full view of those attending the association's annual meeting, when a comparison of grades, names and numbers reveal the winners.

In 1927, one scholarship a year was provided, and that practice was continued for 27 years. In 1954, two scholarships were awarded, and over the years the number of scholarship winners has been increased to three, then four, five and last year six prizes were awarded.

This is quite an accomplishment when you consider that in 1927, the scholarship recipient received the total amount of \$150 for just one year and not for four years; and that in 1984, the first award amounted to \$2200 for the first year and guaran-

teed almost that amount or perhaps more for the next three years.

The trustee of the Scholarship Fund distributed approximately \$31,000 in scholarship awards in 1984. That included payments for scholarship winners of 1984 and those of the three previous years, 1983, 1982 and 1981.

The total amount for the six scholarship winners in 1984 was \$8500.00, which was made possible through contributions by individuals and anniversary classes.

Individual awards are based on the total earnings of the Scholarship Fund's invested capital, and monetary amounts can never be predicted for later years because of the uncertainty concerning the returns on investments.

The dedication of our alumni members in support of the scholarship program is deeply appreciated. We should all be proud to be members of this unique and great organization. We believe it to be the only high school alumni group with a scholarship program that can boast of a record such as noted here. It has truly grown to be a powerful means for doing good.

Special Invitation To Seniors

In addition to the mailing of over 10,000 invitational letters to our alumni members, an invitation was mailed to the parents or guardians of graduating seniors of 1985, asking them to encourage their graduates to get involved with our alumni association. MESSAGE FROM SUPERINTENDENT

I am pleased for this opportunity to welcome Shamokin Area High School Alumni to their 102nd reunion on May 25th. The continued support received from your organization is strong assurance that Shamokin Area graduates hold education in high esteem and their childhood community in high regard.

Please know that the tradition of excellence in our school district is being nurtured by those who attend and teach here. Approximately 40 percent of our graduates continue their education at a two or four year college, an array of vocational training is available, and our district provides an adult evening program with three universities participating as co-presenters. We usually have national merit scholars in our senior class and just this year a recent graduate was named a Rhodes Scholar.

New programs and practices for students and teachers are encouraging. Creative writing is being stressed through composition and reading folders that follow students through all grade levels to graduation, additional required math and science courses have been added, new policies have given better definition toward homework and promotion, and all 8th grade students are required to participate in a keyboarding class using microcomputers. Success cards are now mailed to families of students who have achieved "something special", student accomplishments are recognized by the School Board at public meetings, and a 24 hour telephone announcement program is planned and recorded by students in all grade levels.

Thirty-four of our teachers have volunteered to participate in a re-training program called T.E.S.A. (Teacher Expectations for Student Achievement), which requires evening meetings and four classroom observations monthly. Teachers are also representing our school district with participation in the Chamber of Commerce, the Shamokin Area Industrial Corporation and the annual Trade Fair. Efforts to establish "Adopt-A-School Partnerships" have been successful also with every school in the district engaged with a business or community agency in working collectively on projects.

I would like you to visit with us. As we announce on our telephone answering service, "public education is an investment for the entire community and we invite you to support and participate in our programs."
