Sharon Breining Jones served as song leader for group singing and Irvin Liachowitz provided piano accompaniment.

A moment of silent prayer was observed in memory of Aubrey Phillips, registrar, who died during the past year and all deceased members.

A motion was made by George Lees, seconded by Sarah Neidig Zerby, to accept the secretary's report as published in the invitations, and a motion by Frances Rowe, seconded by Sister May Zajac to also accept the treasurer's report as given in the invitations.

Entertainment was provided by Vic Boris and Irvin Liachowitz with their piano duets and singing by Vic.

Presentation of the Class of 1986 was made by President Korbich and the response was given by Jill Enders, president of the Senior Class. The Class of 1986 was accepted as members of the Alumni Association on a motion made by Dick Hilbush, seconded by Jim Booth. Prize drawings were given by the Program Committee.

Joseph Swatski, High School principal, presented brief remarks pointing out that the association is the only one of its kind that has met continuously during the past 103 years.

President Korbich introduced the new officers. He also thanked all the committees and members of the association for their cooperation and efforts in making the annual reunion successful.

In closing the Senior Class led the singing of the Alma Mater and Rev. Harpster pronounced the benediction.

Many members remained for the "Afterglow" during which Vic Boris and his band provided music for dancing. A buffet lunch was served.
