SECRETARY'S REPORT

The 115th annual reunion of the SAHS Alumni Association was held on Saturday, May 23, 1998 at the Shamokin Area Jr./Sr. High School. The dinner and Afterglow were held in the cafeteria, and the auditorium was the setting for both entertainment and the annual business meeting. Over 350 alumni and guests participated in the festivities. Alumni President Nick Keiser opened the evening by welcoming everyone to the reunion. Rev. William Mengle '35 gave the Invocation followed by a catered dinner served by the Country House Restaurant. Following dinner, members and guests adjourned to the auditorium. The business meeting opened with a few moments of silent prayer for the deceased members of the association. On the motion of Dorothy Zebrowski Goodman '44 and a second by Charles Hoyers '48, the secretary's report was dispensed with since it was in the newsletter. The treasurer's report was also dispensed with on a motion by Marion Grow Marshall '40 and a second by Dick Souden '33.

The Class of 1998 was presented and welcomed into the association. Class President Ryan Pensyl presented the class pennant and recognized the class officers. Irvin

Liachowitz introduced the entertainment, provided by the Shamokin Area String Ensemble. Members of this year's senior class assisted Mary Ann Pitorak Miller, Program Committee, in handing out 26 prizes to individuals holding winning tickets.

Alumni Vice President Susan Kropinski recognized the anniversary classes and any others wishing to make a presentation or announcement. Presentations were as follows:

The presented total of \$17,944 was allocated per each class's instructions to either the General Fund, the H. Richard Hilbush Fund or the Educational Scholarship Fund. Barbara Goldberg Esmond, '58 received the distance award, traveling 7,000 miles from Israel to attend. The Golden Anniversary

Class of 1948 were presented gifts from the association.

Irvin Liachowitz, member of the Educational Trust Fund Committee, introduced the scholarship winners. Forty students signed up for the exam and 26 completed it. This year the Coal Township Alumni Association presented 4 scholarship awards. This year 12 awards were presented ranging from \$500 to \$2,500. Total amount of awards was \$16,400 - given to students up to and including 4 years of schooling at an accredited institution.

Eugene Boughner, Principal of the High School, delivered an impressive address of the accomplishments of the school and the student body.

Boughner reported on an addition of a third state-of-the-art computer lab, advanced physics courses and the introduction of a new community service program. Athletic achievements, vocational accomplishments, musical performances and awards, and academic excellence were given recognition. The forming of a Junior National Honor Society showed 88 Shamokin Junior High School student inductees.


Ratification of the 1998-99 officers nominated by the executive committee followed,

introducing Susan Kropinski '75 as President, Jeffrey Clutcher '78 as Vice President and Registrar, Joan Fauland Eltringham '59 as Secretary, and Helen Jane Murphy '43 as Historian. John Schankweiler '53 moved to accept the nominations and George Shipe '33 seconded. Nominations were closed.

A correction on page 12 under GENERAL FUND of the March 1998 newsletter was noted. The 50 Year class making the donation of \$3005.53 to the general fund was 1947 not 1948 as listed.

The business meeting concluded with the singing of the Alma Mater lead by the senior class and the benediction given by Myron Moskowitz '42. Motion to adjourn was given by Bob Zacker '48 and a second given by Nick Keiser '79. Members and guests returned to the cafeteria for the afterglow where they danced until midnight to the music of Vic Boris' Sound Sensations. A lavish buffet was served at 10 pm. Dorothy Goodman and Heather Cook did a fantastic job getting people to join in the dance contests and musical chairs, with winners receiving prizes.

Faust**, SAHS grad and two-time state wrestling champion, is one of three former wrestlers who have been elected into the Hall of Outstanding Americans of the National Wrestling Hall of Fame. His career record stands at 58-2. Faust has been in private practice as an eye specialist in Leesburg, FL. His state-of-the-art work on laser and cataract surgery has received worldwide praise, and the techniques he pioneered in the field of eye surgery are practiced throughout the globe to this day. He served as the chief of the eye department at the Pensacola Aerospace Regional Medical Hospital until his retirement from military service as a commander in 1971. Faust has been awarded the

“Physician’s Recognition Award” on many occasions.
