SECRETARY'S REPORT

The 116th annual reunion of the Shamokin Area High School Alumni Association was held Saturday May 29th, 1999 at the Shamokin Area High School. The cafeteria was the setting for the dinner and the afterglow, and the auditorium was the setting for the entertainment and business meeting. Participating in the festivities were 325 alumni members and guests. Anniversary pennants flew high. Educational and General Century Club books were on display naming contributors giving \$100 or more from years past. Current contributors' names will be placed in the books.

Alumni president Susan Kropinski '75 opened the evening by welcoming everyone to the reunion. Gene Boughner '60, high school principal gave the invocation. "God Bless America" was lead by Gene Boughner with Irvin Liachowitz '42 accompanying on the piano. Country House Restaurant served a catered dinner. Following dinner, members and guests adjourned to the auditorium. The business meeting opened with a few moments of silent prayer for the deceased members of the association. The secretary and treasurer's reports were in the newsletter, and on a motion by Dorothy Zebrowski Goodman '44 and a second by Ralph Klinger '54, the secretary's report was not given. On a motion of Don Milbrand '48 and a second given by Myron Moskowitz '42, the treasurer's report was not given.

The Class of '99 was presented and welcomed into the association. Class President Mike Spears presented the class pennant.

Bonnie Ensinger Klinger '68 introduced the entertainment and accompanied on the piano. Selections were performed from the

Broadway show "Grease". Lead singer for "Freddie My Love" was Kristyn Shuey, accompanied by Cindy Koeberle, Sabrina Koeberle, Josette Savidge and Jennifer Slodysko. "There Are Worse Things I Could Do" was sung by Jessica Homanick.

Seniors assisting Mary Anne Pitorak Miller '74 of the program committee handed out door prizes to those holding winning tickets.

Susan Kropinski thanked Joan Fauland Eltringham '59 with a gift for her years serving a treasurer and as secretary to the association. Susan also thanked the dinner committee for the work they put into setting everything up.

Alumni Vice-President Jeffrey Clutcher '78 recognized the anniversary classes and any others wishing to make a presentation or announcement.

Malcolm Farrow, who spoke about the Farrow family spanning three centuries, represented class of '29. With a grandson graduating this year, 34 members of the family graduated from Shamokin and another grandson will be graduating in 2004.

Bob Maue represented class of '34, giving a \$1000 donation to the General Fund. Class President Dorothy Moser was recognized, as was the class.

Walter Fidler, who recognized his class members and spoke to the graduating seniors, represented class of '39. A donation of \$1000 was given to the Educational Fund and \$1019.39 to the General Fund.

Dorothy Zebrowski Goodman represented class of '44. Dorothy reported the class had given \$550 and there was more to come.

Class of '49 represented by Bert Klinger and Pat Hoy Engle recognized members in attendance and announced they were donating

\$4900 to Educational Fund and \$1000 to the General Fund.

Harry Strausser who gave an impressive special tribute to teachers Irene Fritz, Richard Hilbush, John Walker, and Frances Rowe represented class of '54. Class members present were recognized. The class donated \$250 to the Educational Fund and \$250 to the General Fund.

Class of '59 will have a picnic in August Joan Fauland Eltringham reported. Class members present were recognized.

Janice Moser Morrison, with a donation of \$255 to the Education Fund, represented the class of '69. Also under '69 Dorothy A. Kemp '43, Bob Kemp '73, and Barbara Kemp Collins '75 donated \$100 in memory of William Kemp, Jr.

John Clutcher, who reported at least \$74 would be donated to the association, represented the class of '74. Adele Wagner Corcoran '49 received the distance award, traveling from London, England. The golden anniversary class was presented with gifts from the association.

Irvin Liachowitz '42, member of the Educational Trust Fund Committee, introduced the scholarship winners. A total of 77 students signed up for the exam and 61 took the exam. This was an exceptionally large turnout for the test. Coal Township Alumni Association gave 4 of the scholarship awards. A total of 13 awards were presented ranging from \$500 to \$2500. The awards totaled \$18,400. These awards are given to students up to and including 4 years at an accredited school. (See page 3 for a listing of all scholarship winners.)


Eugene Boughner '60 high school principal delivered a state of the union address of the school and student body. Highlights of accomplishments included a

grant from the state in excess of \$50,000 for increased scores in assessment testing; the addition of advanced chemistry; tech-prep and career decision courses. 150 students were inducted into the Junior National Honor Society. The "Grease" production was a 2-night sellout. The basketball season was excellent. Boughner also noted with bomb threats going on throughout schools in the United States, Shamokin did not have any threats and he wanted to commend the students.

Joan Rhoades Domnoyer '52 presented the slate of officers for 1999-2000 for ratification. Jeffrey Clutcher '78 President and Registrar, Joan Fauland Eltringham '59 Vice-President, William Korbich '54 Treasurer, Karen Wilk Colangelo '85 secretary and Helen Jane Murphy '43 historian. Myron Moskowitz '42 moved to accept the nominations and John Schankweiler '53 gave a second.

The business meeting concluded with the singing of the Alma Mater lead by the senior class. Myron Moskowitz '42 gave the benediction, given partly in Hebrew. Bruce Clutcher '72 made a motion to adjourn and John Clutcher '74 gave a second. Members and guests returned to the commons area for the afterglow where they danced until 11:30 to the music of Vic Boris' Sound Expression and filled themselves on the buffet served 10 to 11 :30 p.m. Dorothy Zebrowski Goodman '44 chairperson of the afterglow did a fantastic job getting everyone to join in the dance contest and musical chairs. Rich Eltringham assisted. Winners received prizes. Class of '99 danced out the door in a Conga line.

 . . . A. J. Bashore II, '66 SAHS grad had the distinction of performing at Lincoln Center in New York City this past summer. On June 20th at 8 pm in Merkin Concert Hall, A.J. performed a number of selections using the Appalachian mountain dulcimer. This opportunity was made available through receiving a performance award at the Ole Bull Music Festival held in Potter County each October. Bashore is a founding member of two Susquehanna River Valley regional dulcimer clubs, one located in Danville and one located in Mechanicsburg. He is self taught. While A.J. is not making music, his "day job" as a critical care registered nurse at Geisinger Medical Center keeps him busy. He is entering his 29th year of service.

. . . Jeff Fabian, '81 wrote a story about his most memorable fishing outing, which was published
