The 117th annual reunion of the Shamokin Area High School Alumni Association was held Saturday May 27th, 2000 at the Shamokin Area High School. The cafeteria was the setting for the dinner and the afterglow, and the auditorium was the setting for the entertainment and business meeting. Participating in the festivities were 329 alumni members and guests. Anniversary pennants flew high. Educational and General Century Club books were on display naming contributions giving \$100 or more from years past. Current contributors' names will be placed in the books.

Alumni president Jeffrey Clutcher '78 opened the evening by welcoming everyone to the reunion. Rev. Ronald Schellhamer, Pastor Grace Lutheran Church, gave the invocation. "God Bless America" was lead by Jeffrey Clutcher '78 with Irvin Liachowitz '42 accompanying on the piano. Country House Restaurant served a catered dinner. Following dinner, members and guests adjourned to the auditorium. The business meeting opened with a few moments of silent prayer for the deceased members of the association. The secretary's and treasurer's reports were in the newsletter, and on a motion by Dorothy Zebrowski Goodman '44 and a second by Francis Zielinski '42, the secretary's report was not given. On a motion of Brenda Piechowski Messner '80 and (name and class unavailable), the treasurer's report was not given.

The class of 2000 was presented and welcomed into the association. Class president Dan Jones introduced class officers and promised the alumni association the delivery of their pennant at a later date.

Bonnie Ensinger Klinger '68 introduced the entertainment and accompanied on the piano. Selections were performed from the Broadway musical "Crazy for You". Lead actor and actress, Bill Wagner and Jessica Jeremiah performed "Crazy for You" and "Embraceable You". Jessica Jeremiah also performed "I got Rhythm" accompanied by Bill Wagner, Larry Deklinski, Bob Manning, Tiffany Ponatoski, Jenna Rae Arndt, and Mary Anne Brennan.

Seniors assisting Mary Anne Pitorak Miller '74 of the program committee handed out door prizes to those holding winning tickets.

Alumni Vice-President Joan Fauland Eltringham '59 asked Paul McElwee '28 to stand and be recognized. She then recognized the anniversary classes and any other wishing to make a presentation or announcement.

1930 - Sara Haas Tillett reminded her

class of their class flower, white rose; class colors, silver and blue; motto, 'Forward ever Backward never'. Sara acknowledged the accomplishments of Harold Roadarmel and the success of her classmates. A donation of \$600 for the Educational Fund.

1935 - Geraldine Keating McFalls presented to the Alumni her class gift of \$875 to the Educational Fund and \$225 to the General Fund.

1940 - Special Memorial Donation William Korbich '54 recognized the Class of 40. The class of 40 decided to donate in honor of one of their classmates, Mr. H. Richard Hilbush for his volunteer work and dedication to the Alumni Association. Thirty-five members donated to the H. Richard Memorial Fund a total of \$2430. In addition, a special thanks was given to John Schankweiler '53 for his help on the Banquet, to Flo and Joan for their efforts and success of the great turnout of the Class of '50. Forty-eight members attended tonight with a total of 77 including guests of '50. William Korbich concluded with the reading of a letter he received in the mail from the son of Dorothy Mead Long '24. He stated how his mother enjoys her Alumni newsletter, and how they both just recently looked through her yearbook and shared her memories. Dorothy will be 95 on June 11. Included with this letter was a contribution of \$50.

1960 - Linda Weimer Gard and Linda Musser Knopp asked the four members present to stand. 165 graduated in the year 1960, and they were proud to state that 35 members attended their class reunion. A donation of \$1000 to the Educational Fund and \$450 to the General Fund in memory of 10 class members and two class advisors whom recently past away in the past 10 years was given. At this time, a plaque in memory of Elmer Artman and H. Richard Hilbush was given to Eugen Boughner, Principal.

1970 - Class was recognized and asked to stand.

1975 - Silver Anniversary: Sue Kropinski announced the class will celebrate in September and spoke to the graduating class. Sue shared her class trivia and now and then statistics. She challenged the Class of 2000 to share their class memories in 25

years. In addition she quizzed the Class of 2000 on their own class trivia. We learned that the Class of 2000's flower is the yellow rose; colors are purple and silver; and their song is 'I will remember you'.

1950 - Golden Anniversary: Flo Howerter Milbrand introduced the recipient of the Alumni Scholarship Award for the Class of '50, Clarence Kerstetter Reed. Clarence addressed the Class of 2000 with respect as Ladies and Gentlemen and spoke to them about his high school years and how appreciative he was of his award. He told them they have something special that they will always have, 'the heritage of Shamokin' and to think of a rowboat. 'What can you do with a rowboat?' He explained that it can only work by manual means. You can make it go fast and forward or do nothing. But if you let it do nothing, something might happen. A wind or current might take it to an unwanted place. He told them that when you are the rower, you must row effectively, look behind you and envision the heritage of Shamokin. He congratulated the Class of 2000 and wished them good rowing. Flo Howerter Milbrand asked her class to stand and be recognized. A donation of \$1950 to the Educational Fund and \$1950 to the General Fund was given. An additional \$385 to the Educational Fund and \$211 to the General Fund for a total of \$4,496.

The Golden Anniversary class was presented with gifts from the association.

Jane Zielinski McKeon '50 received the distance award, traveling from San Jose, California.

Irvin Liachowitz '42 member of the Educational Trust Fund Committee, introduced the scholarship winners. Coal Township Alumni Association gave 4 scholarship awards. A total of 15 awards were presented ranging from \$500 to \$2500. The awards totaled \$19,000. These awards are given to students up to and including 4 years at an accredited school. Eugen Boughner '60, high school principal, addressed the alumni and spoke of the many accomplishments of the Shamokin Area School District. He listed a wide span of accredited schools of which the Class of 2000 will attend in the Fall. Some of the highlights of the past school year included musical "Crazy for You", a very active SADD team, District Band and Chorus, Community Concerts to list a few mentioned. The students of Shamokin can excel in AP chemistry, statistics, and calculus. Honor Science courses have been added to the Junior High curriculum. He commended the Prayer Club on meeting every day at 7am in the auditorium (the alumni

applauded this group), the Random Acts of Kindness, National Honor Society on their service to the Red Cross, Cancer, Soldiers and Children of Bosnia. Congratulations to the seniors who finished their senior project. These graduation projects are state mandated. Several seniors completed surveys, did community service, presented drug programs, and created web pages as their projects. Special thanks and recognition to the PTA for their successful RIFF program. The students receive free books through donation of the PTA. Mr. Boughner announced the addition of a Mass Media course and Latin through distance learning to be added to next year's course selections. In addition, he stated Shamokin is proud to be one of the few schools to honor our Veterans. The school just recently held a special program honoring the Veterans and received compliments from Col. Keith Martin on our students' behavior and respect. In conclusion, he told the Alumni not to worry and he is proud of our students.

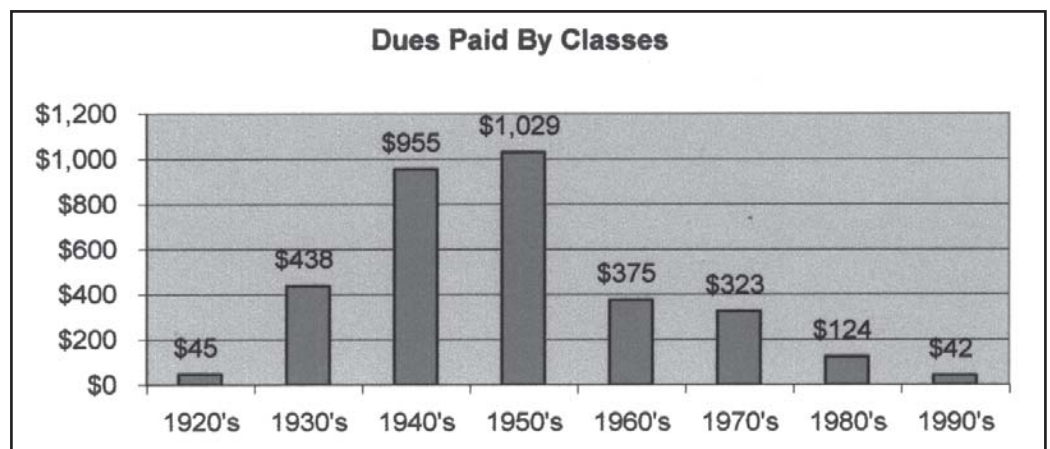
