SECRETARY'S REPORT

The 120th annual reunion of the Shamokin Area High School Alumni Association was held Saturday, May 24th, 2003 at the Shamokin Area High School. The cafeteria was the setting for the dinner and afterglow, and the auditorium was the setting for the entertainment and business meeting. Participating in the festivities were 352 alumni members and guests. Educational and General Century Club books were on display naming contributions of \$100 or more from years past. Current contributors' names will be placed in the books.

The evening began with the invocation given by Shirley Fisher Jackson '51. This was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and singing of God Bless America with Irvin Liachowitz '42 as the accompanist. Dinner was prepared by and served by Lavis Caterer. At the conclusion of dinner, Alumni President Joan Rhoades Donmoyer '52 introduced the officers and welcomed everyone to the reunion. She then invited everyone to attend the business meeting in the auditorium. The business meeting opened with motion by Beverly Yocum and a second by Claire Varney to accept the secretary's minutes as printed. On a motion by John Klinger and second by Shirley Fisher Jackson the treasurer's report was accepted as printed.

President, Joan Rhoades Donmoyer '52 asked for a moment of silent prayer in recognition of the deceased members of the association.

The class of 2003 was presented and welcomed into the association. Class president, Dustin Martin, presented their pennant to the Alumni Association. He thanked the Alumni for the Banquet and opportunity to receive scholarships. Bonnie Klinger introduced the evening's entertainment. The Harmony Hunnies, a girls barbershop quartet, composed of Susan Horan, Laura Backes, Amanda Jeremiah, and Lauren Graboski. The girls sang a Gospel Medley, Somewhere Out There, and Shaboom. Mary Anne Pitorak Miller '74, program committee representative, handed out door prizes to those holding winning tickets. Members of

the Class of 2003 assisted in the distribution. There were approximately 60 winners this evening.

Alumni Vice-President John Clutcher '74 recognized the anniversary classes and any other class wishing to make a presentation or announcement.

70th year anniversary 1933 - Two members were in attendance this evening Reba Hirsh and Leona Grossman.

65th year anniversary 1938 - Presenting for her class, Kathryn Yakubick, gave the alumni the class donation of \$765. She presented to the Alumni a gift from Amelia Campbell '30 her donation of \$100. Amelia is 90 years old.

60th year anniversary 1943 - Sal Neidig presented the Alumni Association with a donation to the general fund the amount of \$1140 from her class.

40th year anniversary 1963 - Carol Swatt Dudinskie presented the Alumni Association with a donation in the amount of \$2726. She had explained that this collection has only taken place in the last few days. She also recognized six individuals who gave generously to this collection for her class; William Barr, Charles Sosnoski, Linda Strausser Herb, Mark & Nancy Whitley Clark, Judith Twigg Reinhardt, and Victoria Barr.

30th year anniversary 1973 - Jeffrey Schlader presented the Association with a donation of \$100. He also presented the Alumni with another donation of \$100 from Francis Schlader '38.

45th year anniversary 1958 - Shirley Rando Persing presented in honor of her class a donation of \$910.

55th year anniversary 1948 - Dorothy Malone presented the Association with a donation of \$1,600 for the general fund from her class.

25th year anniversary 1978 - Silver Anniversary - Jeffrey Clutcher informed the group that his class would be having their Silver Reunion on August 16th.

50th year anniversary 1953 - Golden Anniversary - John Schankweiler represented his class with the generous donation of \$24,300. He said his class has been

These were the 9th, 5th, 4th, 3rd and 1st awards. A total of 11 awards were presented ranging from \$700 to \$2,500. The awards totaled \$17,700. Several teachers will be retiring this year. Mr. Boughner stated 2003-2004 would be his last year. He welcomed Ned Sodrick '67 as incoming superintendent. Mr. Boughner listed a wide span of accredited colleges and universities the class of 2003 has been accepted to. He encouraged us to recognize the good our students do and focus on the positive.

Joan Rhoades Donmoyer presented the slate of officers for 2003-2004 for ratification: President John Clutcher '74; Vice President, Shirley Fisher Jackson '51; Treasurer, William Korbich '54; Secretary, Karen Wilk Colangelo '85; Historian, Helen Jane Murphy '43; and Registrar, Jeffrey Clutcher '78. On motion by Susan Kropinski '75 and second by Mary Anne Pitorak Miller '74 the slate was accepted and voted in by all in attendance.

The business meeting concluded with the singing of the Alma Mater. Myron Moskowitz '42 gave the benediction. Members and guests returned to the cafeteria for the afterglow.

and be home in time for their pill.


And now I can't wait;


