SECRETARY'S REPORT

The 121st annual reunion of the Shamokin Area High School Alumni Association was held Saturday May 29th, 2004 at the Shamokin Area High School. The cafeteria was the setting for the dinner and afterglow, and the auditorium was the setting for the entertainment and business meeting. Participating in the festivities were 321 alumni members and guests. Educational and General Century Club books were on display naming contributions of \$100 or more from years past. Current contributors' names will be placed in the books.

The evening began with the invocation given by Alumni President John Clutcher '74. This was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and singing of God Bless America with Irvin Liachowitz '42 as the accompanist. John Clutcher '74 introduced the officers and welcomed everyone to the reunion. After dinner, he invited everyone to attend the business meeting in the auditorium. Dinner was prepared and served by Lavis Catering.

Alumni President, John Clutcher '74 opened the business meeting with a silent prayer in memory of the deceased members.

A motion by Bob Carr '54 and a second by Albert Geasey '54 to accept the secretary's minutes as printed. On a motion by Helen Jane Murphy '43 and second by Sara Neidig Zerby '43 the treasurer's report was accepted as printed.

The class of 2004 was asked to stand and be recognized. John Clutcher wished the class best of luck. Class president, Amber Backes, presented their pennant to the Alumni Association.

Bonnie Klinger introduced the evening's entertainment. Three songs were selected and performed from this year's musical, Footloose. The performers were Joe Hardin '04, Curt Troxel '05, Tony Wondoloski '07, Todd Fiddler '04, Kerry Kramer '04, Kiera Thompson '04, Laura Backes '04, Katie Stroh '04, Angelic Christian '04, Wendy Jacobs '06.

Mary Anne Pitorak Miller '74, program committee representative, handed out door prizes to those holding winning tickets. Members of the Class of 2003 and Susan Kropinski assisted in the distribution. There were approximately 35 winners this evening.

Alumni Vice-President Shirley Fisher Jackson '51 recognized the anniversary classes and any other class wishing to make a presentation or announcement. The

anniversary classes were asked to stand and be recognized.

70th year anniversary 1934 -

One member was in attendance this evening. A donation of \$140 was received.

65th year anniversary 1939 -

Presenting for his class, Walter Fidler gave the alumni the class donation of \$800 for the scholarship fund and \$519.39 for the General Fund. The total class donation was \$1319.39. Mr. Fidler commended his classmates for their donations. He reminded the audience the class of 1939 are of a generation born during the Depression and matured with the advent of World War II. Many have served in the Armed Services; several who made the supreme sacrifice, others successful in their various fields of endeavor. Out of the 211 graduating members, the Class of 1939 presently has 61 members.

60th year anniversary 1944 -

Dorothy Zebrowski Goodman, class secretary, introduced her class officers: J Harold Herb, President, Marion Derr Herb, Vice President, and Jeanne Malick Shutt, Treasurer. The class donated to the general fund the amount of \$1415 and \$1585 to the scholarship fund. The total class donation was \$3000.

Shirley Fisher Jackson thanked everyone presenting and all members of the donating classes for their generosity.

At this time, Susan Kropinski and Mary Ann Pitorak Miller made the presentation of gifts to the Golden Anniversary Class from the SAHS Alumni Association.

Two distance awards were given to due the close proximity of our winners. Donald Bixler '43, Huntington Beach, CA and Vera Lou Hershey '49, Bairbank, CA will each receive a distance Award.

Irvin Liachowitz '42 member of the Educational Trust Fund Committee, introduced the scholarship winners. Coal Township Alumni Association gave 6 scholarship awards. These were the 9th, 7th, 5th, 4th, 3rd and 1st awards. A total of 12 awards were presented ranging from \$500 to \$2500. The awards totaled \$19100. These awards are given to students up to and including 4 years at an accredited school. Fifty-one students participated in the testing process. Awards were as follows:

Ned Sodrick '67, superintendent, addressed the alumni and shared current and past statistical information about the Shamokin Area School District. He commended Eugene Boughner on forty years of many contributions and service to the district. He introduced the incoming principal, Chris Venna. He concluded his presentation with

a scene from a 1943 movie that repeatedly referred to Shamokin in a song. The title of the song was "Bloke from Shamokin" sung by Marcy McGuire.

Eugene Boughner '60, high school principal, addressed the alumni and spoke of the many accomplishments of the students. He highlighted the following: "Footloose" musical, District, Regional, State Chorus, Band and Orchestra; new courses in AP Computer Technology, AP Biology, Biochemistry; Math curriculum reevaluated and new prerequisites and standards set, entire curriculum is being mapped and aligned to state standards to meet NCLB requirements; two veteran's programs; Track & Field competing in state's; football won District IV; girl's basketball won District IV and went into state playoffs; girl's soccer won overall championship in Schuylkill League; Baseball in District IV playoffs; one senior attended Gov. School for Computer Technology; sixty students participated in AP exams; State Police canine search; updated computer Tech Ed Lab; gymnasium repainted; new stage curtains; twenty-six new teachers hired; second largest group of Juniors inducted into Honor Society. Mr. Boughner listed a wide span of accredited colleges and universities the class of 2004 has been accepted to. He encouraged us to recognize the good our students do and focus on the positive.

John Clutcher thanked Eugene Boughner for his many years of service and presented him with a gift certificate from the Alumni.

James Booth conducted the election of three directors to the Education (scholarship) committee. The new directors are Irvin Liachowitz '42, Eugene Boughner '60, and Joan Fauland Eltringham '59. By motion given by Bill Korbich and John Clutcher the new board of directors were accepted and voted in. The new directors will serve a term of five years.

John Clutcher presented the slate of officers for 2004-2005 for ratification: President - Shirley Fisher Jackson '51; Vice President - John Klinger '68; Treasurer - William Korbich '54; Secretary - Karen Wilk Colangelo '85; Historian - Helen Jane Murphy '43; Registrar - Jeffrey Clutcher '78. On motion by Susan Kropinski '75 and second by Claire Clutcher Varney '62 the slate was accepted and voted in by all in attendance.

The business meeting concluded with the singing of the Alma Mater. Myron Moskowitz '42 gave the benediction. Members and guests returned to the cafeteria for the afterglow.

and be home in time for their pill.

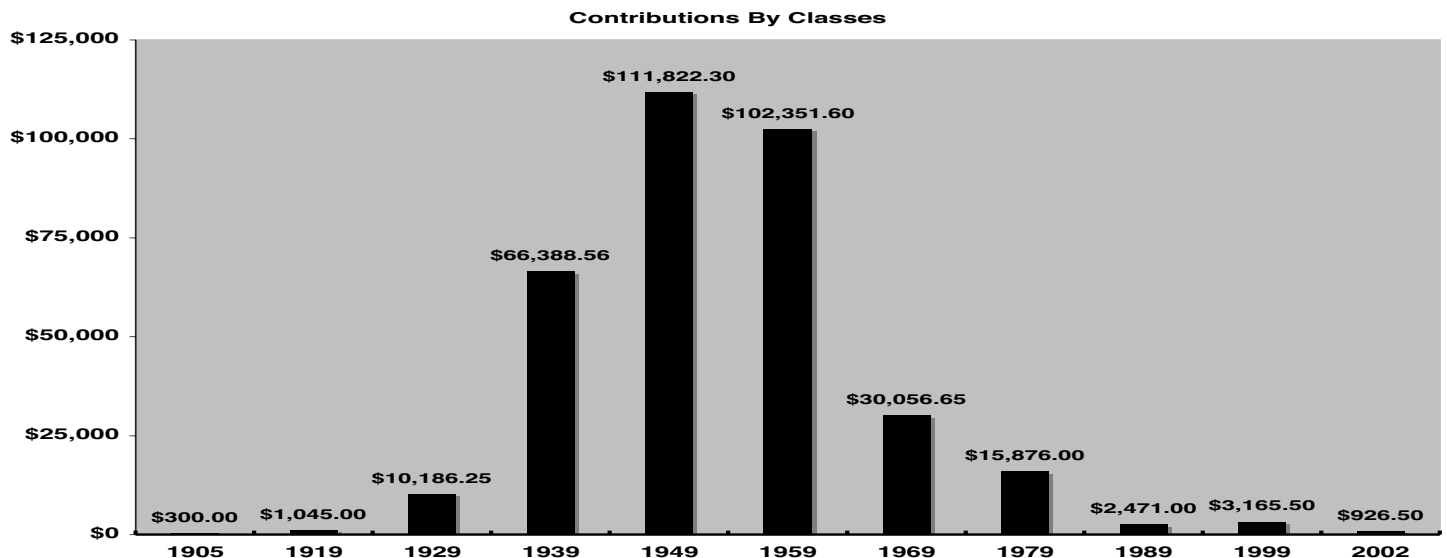
And now I can't wait;
