GENERAL FUND FINANCIAL SITUATION

In order for an organization to remain strong it needs the support of its members. In the case of an alumni association, the members who have remained in the immediate area of the association are available to physically support the association. Those that have moved from the area do not have that opportunity.

However, both those in the immediate area and those who have moved have the opportunity, (and more so the responsibility) to support the association financially.

Your executive committee wants each member to have the opportunity to read news about your alumni association. Each year over 11,000 newsletters are mailed to alumni members. We realize that many of them are discarded without being looked at (yet alone read). In order for this information to be received, it just be printed and mailed. The cost for this averages about \$1.00 per member.

The amount of money received for the general fund \$10,966 was donated by 306 members of the association. This is very commendable. However, this is only 2.8% of the total membership. There are additional general expenses throughout the year as well as expenses for the banquet. This year the General Fund contributions were \$4,617 less than the average for the past 5 or 6 years. The Dues contributions were down \$175. If you look at the financial report you will notice that the ending balance for 2006 is \$4,968 less than the 2005 ending balance. This is very close to the amount of the difference in contributions from past years. We were generally carrying a \$12,000 balance each year. If the missing 97.2% of the membership would just send in their annual dues of \$2.00 or a small donation of \$1.00 to the general fund we would remain financially solvent.

If this trend of less dues and contributions continues, another deficit contribution of \$4,617 will bring the balance down to about \$3,000.

Some of you graduated from Shamokin High School, others from Shamokin Joint High School and more recently Shamokin Area High School. It really does not matter what the name of the school was when you graduated, you should have some fond memories that would move you to make an effort to keep the Shamokin Area High School Alumni Association solvent.
