The Banquet began with President John Klinger '68 welcoming everyone to the festivities. The invocation was given by Rev. James Williams '56 followed by the pledge to the flag and signing of "God Bless America."

Upon completion of dinner, the business meeting commenced with President John Klinger asking all Veterans to stand and be recognized. President Klinger then asked all to stand for a moment of silence for military veterans. 
