by volunteering their time and services for those in need. Many of our students volunteer their time for the Salvation Army and Red Cross and others serve as volunteers in local nursing and personal care homes.

At the high school, various new programs and initiatives continue to be implemented. This school year we had twenty-nine students participating in the Dual Enrollment Program. This program is an agreement between the Shamokin Area School District and both Bloomsburg University and Luzerne County Community College, in which qualified high school juniors and seniors may enroll in college general education classes and count these grades and credits for graduation and college transfer study. These students can earn up to thirty-six undergraduate credits before they cross the stage to receive their high school diploma.

Our students have also benefited this year from a grant titled Classrooms for

the Future. This new program will transform our students' education from the traditional textbook, chalk and blackboard experience to one that utilizes computers, the Internet and enhanced technology. We have received approximately eight Interactive Whiteboards and one hundred fifty-eight laptop computers for our students and teachers to utilize with the goal of increasing student achievement. Our technology at the school is progressing rapidly and we continue to aggressively pursue opportunities for our students!

Once again, I would like to take this opportunity to thank the Shamokin Area High School Alumni Association for your support. Enjoy your visit with classmates, friends, and family. You have my best wishes for a memorable reunion weekend.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

Minutes – May 26, 2007
Meeting/Banquet

The Shamokin Area High School Alumni Association's 124th annual reunion was held on May 26th at the Elysburg Fire Co. Elysburg, PA and catered by Masser's Catering. A total of 280 were present. Books from the 25th, 50th, 75th and 100th anniversaries were on display along with books containing names of contributors over the years to the general and educational century clubs. The Banquet began with President Mary Anne Pitorak Miller '74 welcoming everyone to the festivities and introducing the officers at the head table. The invocation was given by Rev. Navon Satyavrata of St. Johns United Methodist Church and followed by the pledge to the flag and singing of "God Bless America" accompanied by Irvin Liachowitz '42.

Upon completion of dinner, the business meeting was called to order by President Mary Anne Pitorak Miller '74. President Miller began with a moment of silence to remember all deceased Alumni and especially for Robert Sheetz and Matthew Sandri who died while serving in the Armed Forces in Iraq. A motion to accept the annual secretary report as written in the bulletin was given by John Schankweiler '53 and second by Shirley Fisher Jackson '51. The motion was carried. John Klinger '68 made a motion to accept the treasurer report as written in the bulletin. Eugene Boughner '60 seconded the motion. On the vote, the motion was carried.

President Miller asked the class of 2007 to stand and be recognized. Tony Wondoloski, President of the Senior Class, presented their pennant.

The barbershop quartet from Shamokin Area High School entertained the Alumni with two songs accompanied by Bonny Ensinger Klinger '68. Members of the quartet were Tony Wondoloski, Andrew Choffel, Eric Troxell, and Jasper Lloyd.

Next, the door prizes were presented by Susan Kropinski '75 and John Klinger with the assistance from members of the current senior class. More than 50 door prizes were awarded.

Vice President Barry Michael Buriak '62 recognized the anniversary classes. Class of 1937 was celebrating their 70th Year Reunion.

Class of 1942 – Williard Wagner addressed the Alumni and presented a gift to the Association in the amount of \$2,075.

Class of 1947 – Shirley Edwards Hughes recognized her class and commended them for their dedication to the Association. A gift in the amount of \$4,747 was presented to the Association to be divided as \$1,000 Century Fund, \$800 Education Fund, \$1,020 General Fund, and \$1,927 Class of 1947.

Class of 1967 will be celebrating their 40th Anniversary in July.

Class of 1977 was celebrating their 30th Anniversary.

Classes of 1987 and 1997 were recognized.

Class of 1952 was asked to stand and be recognized. The class members have decided to send their gifts directly to the Alumni Association and to celebrate their 55th Anniversary at this year's banquet.

Class of 2006 was represented by Bonny Ensinger Klinger. Mrs. Klinger announced on behalf of the Senior Class Advisors, Linda Venn and Noreen Schwalm, the Class of 2006 is donating the remaining amount of \$550 from their activities account to the Association.

Silver Anniversary Class of 1982 was recognized.

Golden Anniversary Class of 1957 was recognized and asked to stand. Kay Barr Berry '57 represented her class and presented to the Alumni Association their gift of \$24,686. The gift is for the General Scholarship Fund and Peter J. Malafi Award. The Alumni Association presented a gift to each member present. Mr. Korbich said in past years on average only 30-35 members attend, and the gift order is placed in advance of the RSVP date of the banquet.

Chris Venna, Shamokin Area Middle School/Senior High School Principal, thanked the alumni association for its efforts and generosity for the students. He shared the academic successes in the past year which included the dual enrollment program for students to earn college credits. Several students will begin their college years with one semester completed. He reported that students take AP courses and are scoring well on the AP exams. Students have been accepted to various colleges and universities. Mr. Venna shared the athletic successes. "Girl's volleyball made district playoffs (1st time ever), girls soccer, boys and girls basketball all qualified for district playoffs. The Girl's basketball team was District 4 Champions. In swimming, two individual league champions and a relay

team that was also league champs. Two wrestlers made it to regional competition. Mr. Venna announced the accomplishments of our students in Music & Arts. Some of these included excellent concerts and programs, the musical production of "Seussical", students qualifying for district, regional, and state festivals in band, chorus, and orchestra, and the hosting of District 8 Orchestra Festival. Mr. Venna also noted the student's successes in Service. He commended the students on their volunteer work for SACH, Salvation Army, Special Olympics, and Relay for Life. Mr. Venna then shared the continual progress on upgrading the curriculum, the opportunity for students to utilize an environmental center located near the votech school, recognized the facilities as one of the best in the state, and shared the awards of two teachers as being recognized as WBRE Teacher of the Month and Wal-Mart Teacher of the Year. He concluded with thanking everyone and commending the Association for providing the scholarship opportunities to the students.

The ratification of 3 trustees to the education committee was conducted by Joan Fauland Eltringham '59, Trustee Committee President. William Korbich, James Booth '48 and John Schankweiler '53 were nominated for a five-year term. Kathleen Eltringham made a motion to accept the nominees. Robert Carr seconded the motion.
