Once again, I can proudly announce that our students continue to represent Shamokin Area well in a variety of areas. Academically, our school has had its best overall state assessment results in school history. In August, our school district was recognized as one of the top fifty (13 out of 50) most-improved school districts in Pennsylvania and the high school received a Keystone Achievement Award (for meeting AYP for two

consecutive years) for the first time in school history. Minutes/Summary May 23, 2009

The Shamokin Area High School Alumni Association's 126th (1883- 2009) anniversary reunion was held on Saturday May 23rd at the Masser Banquet Hall Paxinos, Pennsylvania. The President Susan Salvatore Reed '78 thanked everyone for attending and all the committee members for their fine job this past year. The Reverend Beverly Petrovich from the Johnston City United Methodist Church, Ranshaw gave the invocation. Following the invocation Irvin Liachowitz '42 lead the alumni and their guests in a stirring rendition of "God Bless America", then the Pledge of Allegiance. Following the delicious meal the business meeting was held. The meeting was called to order at 7p.m. A moment of silence was given for a silent prayer for deceased alumni members. The president asked for a motion to waive the reading of the minutes and to accept them as published in the Alumni Association News. Bob Platt '59 made the motion; it was seconded and so moved. Likewise with the treasurer's report. Dorothy Zebrowski Goodman '44 made the motion to accept; it was seconded and so moved.

President Sue Salvatore Reed '78 asked the Class of 2009 to rise and be recognized. The senior class president, Courtney Conrad, presented the Alumni Association with the 2009 class pennant. Vice president Jim Backes '80 hung their pennant next to the others on display. Entertainment was provided by the senior class cast members from the spring musical, "The Wiz", lead by their director Rebecca Brandt. They sang three selections, "Be a Lion"; "What Would I Do If I Could Feel"; and "Everyone Rejoice" from the musical. The prize drawings were held next by the program committee, with Mary Anne Pitorak Miller '74 calling the winners' names.

President Susan Salvatore Reed '78 introduced vice president Jim Backes '80 who would recognize the anniversary classes. First Jim wanted to recognize a very special alumnus, Walt Hill, who was here to celebrate his 77th year (class of 1932) reunion. Walt was accepted at Penn State to play football and would have been on the team prior to Joe Paterno being there but due to the Great Depression choose to attend Bloomsburg University and stay closer to home at that time. A warm round of applause acknowledged this milestone for Mr. Hill. The first class to be recognized was the Class of 1939 with 3 members from the original 215 graduating class attending. Mr. Walter Fidler gave a very poignant and amusing tribute to the members of the armed services and the similarities to his class and the class of 2009. He

and his fellow class members donated \$419.39 to the Alumni Association.

The class of 1944 had 2 members present. On behalf of the class of 1949 representative Patricia Hoy Engle donated \$551.00 to the general fund and \$1949.00 to the education fund with 12 of her fellow class members present. No one was present from the class of 1954. The class of 1956 again made a special contribution for the second year in a row with \$195.60 going to the general fund presented by their representative, Winifred Ginck Nemecek. No one was available for the classes of 1964 and 1969.

The Golden Anniversary class of 1959 had 31 members present. Presenters Robert Welker and Joan Fauland Eltringham jokingly said they had to go on two cruises to raise all their money. Of course selling shelf sitters, golf tournaments and other fund raising went into their amazing contribution. \$1119.59 was donated to the general fund; \$9719.59 to the education fund and \$200.00 dollars to the Mr. H. Richard Hilbush scholarship fund. Members of the class of 2009 distributed presents to those in attendance from the 50th year anniversary class of 1959. William Korbich mention addition coal memorabilia presents were available and could be purchased from him.

Vice president Jim Backes '80 was forced to rule the long distance award a tie this year, two members were visiting from California, one from Los Angeles and one from Burbank. Both would receive plaques recognizing their dedication.

Mr. Irvin Liachowitz '42 stated that 52 students had signed up for the scholarship test but sadly only 30 students actually took the exam. He then proceeded with the naming of this year's scholarship winners. These are all four year scholarships, but the amount is determined each year by the Educational Fund Trustees.

All recipients warmly thanked both alumni associations for their generous support. A complete list of names can be seen on Page 3.

President Susan Salvatore Reed '78 then introduced Mr. Chris J. Venna principal of the Shamokin Area Middle/High School. Principal Venna was recently named the winner of the Dr. Walt Kealey Leadership award. Nominated by the Shamokin PTA for his outstanding dedication to the students and the school he was chosen by the Board of Pennsylvania PTA as principal of the year. Principal Venna thanked everyone in attendance and proceeded to list all the many accomplishments academically; athletically; in arts and musical events; and socially that the students participate in the community.

The students continue to take additional classes from Luzerne County Community College, with 5 students qualifying for advanced placement exams. This year's PSAA's scores were the highest ever in the history of the school. The team for the stock market simulation competition took first place in the state over 6000 teams that competed. They continue to ask and receive grant money for new online courses technology at the school. New renovations in the auditorium, new improved lighting in the school for additional energy savings, stimulus money for after school programs and improved technology are a few of the many ongoing projects at the middle/high school. Mr. Venna gave a summary of all the school's athletic achievements for the year. He also gave an overview of the arts and musical students' accomplishments along with the students that excelled at the Vocation School and their awards. Mr. Venna told the alumni that baccalaureate services would be held on June 1st at 7:00p.m. The Awards ceremony would be held the following evening, June 2nd at 6:30 p.m. with commencement on June 4th at 6:30 p.m. He again thanked the Alumni Association for all their fine work and support for the students.

John Schankweiler '53 president of the Educational Fund Committee ratified the nomination of the three directors; Irvin Liachowitz '42, Joan Fauland Eltringham '59, and Eugene Boughner '60 to their 5 year terms on the education fund (scholarship) committee. On the vote, the new slate was accepted.

Nominations for the new alumni association officers were presented by Susan Salvatore Reed '78. On the vote, the new slate was accepted. Susan Salvatore Reed '78 presented to the attending alumni incoming president James Backes '80 and Charmaine Tetkoskie '82 vice president. She warmly thanked Masser's and the wait staff for the great job they did at the banquet. She also thanked the committee members again for all their hard work and asked everyone to give them a round of applause.

The business meeting concluded with the singing of the Alma Mater lead by the class of 2009, followed by the benediction by Reverend Beverly Petrovich.

A motion to adjourn was made and so moved. Everyone was invited to stay for the afterglow festivities with music provided by Victor Boris '66 and the Sound Expression. A buffet was also served.
