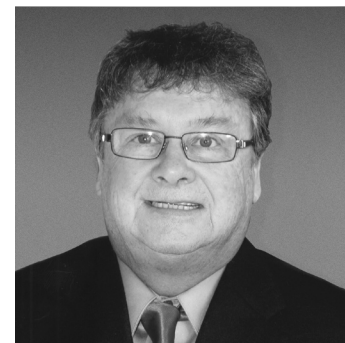
Our Banquet Committee offers special congratulations to the Anniversary classes and salutes the superior academic achievements of our graduating seniors from the Class of 2014.
