## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

It has been my honor and privilege to serve as your alumni president this past year. Although I have been involved with the alumni steering committee over the years, this is my first opportunity serving as an officer for this outstanding organization. Surrounding me is a dedicated group of fellow alumni who make up the core of the organization. These faithful alumni maintain the mailing database (no small task!), plan the annual banquet, write and print this newsletter, maintain our website presence, track and store memorabilia, promote the organization through various publicity and outreach efforts, maintain the by-laws, track the organization's finances and pay the bills.

Your SAHS Alumni Association continues to partner with the High School to get our organization's name out in front of our seniors...our next generation who will eventually assume the responsibilities for this organization. Last June, I had the honor as the Association's Vice President, to assist then Alumni President, Tammy Linton Glowatski '87, in handing out cash awards and recognitions at the 2017 High School Scholastic Awards Program. The SAHS Alumni main-

tains 19 memorial awards from the endowments established in honor of a respected alumnus or inspiring teacher. Over 30 students received monetary awards from the Association during that June 7th program. Each award was accompanied by a brief recognition and remembrance of the honored individual for whom the respective endowments are named.

As fellow alumni, you can take pride in the Association's ability to provide substantial financial awards to merited seniors through both these endowed funds as well as the general SAHS and Coal Township scholarship funds. The SAHS Alumni Scholarship Fund has grown, over many years, to its current balance of just over one million dollars. We are grateful for this seemingly huge endowment and recognize it has been created over a 135-year period of time, with alumni sacrificially giving a few dollars or thousands. Your Association manages a conservative investment approach minimizing funding risks yet allowing the funds to grow, enabling us to keep pace with rising educational costs as well as reaching out to an increasing number of students each year. When I graduated in 1972 only four



seniors had opportunity to receive alumni scholarships. Last year the SAHS Alumni Association awarded eight merit based scholarships ranging from \$1,200 - \$3,000/year for each of 4 consecutive years, to graduating seniors. ...15 scholarships total including the Coal Township Alumni Association awards.

Each year, at Masser's Restaurant in Paxinos, we celebrate our SAHS Alumni's existence by gathering for our annual banquet on the Saturday of Memorial Day weekend. Details for this year's event are found on pages 3 and 19. I hope you can join us for dinner, fellowship and the privilege of awarding another eight SAHS Alumni and seven Coal Township Alumni Association scholarships to our graduating seniors.
