Opening invocation was given by Rev. Betsy Martin Bruaw '83.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and Irvin Berlin's song "GOD BLESS AMERICA" was sung by all attending. Vic Boris Trio provided accompaniment.

Bruce Clutcher '72 - President of the Alumni Association - provided the Banquet introductions for the business meeting. A delicious meal was provided by Masser's Catering. After dessert, the business meeting started with a silent prayer in memory of the deceased members on the program, which totaled 196.
