# SECRETARY'S REPORT

Traditionally the banquet business meeting details are printed in the newsletter, but 2020 was no ordinary year with us needing to cancel the banquet and hold a virtual scholarship awards ceremony with the school district administration. Instead, this year we will provide some highlights of recent meeting minutes and additional noteworthy information.

**From April 2020...**

**NEW BUSINESS:**

- John Klinger '68 made a motion to accept the nomination of officers for 2020-2021, seconded by Susan Kropinski Haas '75. All were in favor.

The election of Tammy Linton Glowatski – '87 to fill the un-expired term (until 2021) of the late Myron M. Moskowitz as a trustee of the Educational Fund was ratified.

At the February 2020 meeting of the trustees, Matthew Weller – '91 was elected President and Dr. Raymond General – '91 was elected Vice President. Frances Lee Culp – '63 who served as Secretary for many years, resigned from that position (she remains as a trustee). A new secretary will be appointed.

**From October 2020...**

**TREASURER'S REPORT:**

Gregory Dwulet '68 provided the treasurer's update. Greg spoke about contributions and donations being down due to COVID.

He reported a donation made by Nathan Weidenhamer '02 and his sister, Deanna '96. When they were seniors, both received a scholarship. They provided a donation of \$7,500 for an annual award based on the investment earnings. This award would go to a female senior who has the highest GPA in STEM related subjects - science, technology, engineering, and math – who expects to enter a STEM field in post-graduate work.

The consensus was to create a new award called the Weidenhamer Family Award starting in 2021. This new award may generate approximately \$200 a year. This could build up over time, especially if additional contributions are added. A new award cannot pull down from principal, but needs to be awarded from growth only.

**MEMORABILIA COMMITTEE:**

Maxine Howerter-Harvey '83 needs to step down as Historian for the alumni association. Approved by the group, the Historian responsibilities will be combined with the work of the Registrar.

**From January 2021...**

**BANQUET:**

John Klinger '68 reported this year's banquet is good to go, but undetermined if the event will occur in 2021 due to COVID-19. The date for the banquet is Memorial Day weekend, Saturday, May 29, 2021 at Masser's Banquet Hall, Paxinos, PA. If the event occurs, social distancing and masks will be required. ## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS.....

### **Q: Does the alumni association plan and/or help pay for individual class reunions?**

A: Each class is responsible to fund their own class reunion. The alumni association does not get involved at that level. You can reach out to the class representatives listed on the webpage to see if they can provide input. Jeff Clutcher '78, registrar, can provide your planning committee mailing labels from our database for your group to send out a letter to classmates about what your committee may be planning, location, cost, cutoff dates to receive payment, etc. John Clutcher '74 can post details about your reunion out on the alumni association webpage when information becomes finalized.

### **Q: What scholarships does the alumni association provide?**

A: We provide alumni scholarship awards through a test given in spring to seniors who register. We also administer the fund distribution of alumni subject awards. Details on both items are located on the alumni web page under "Educational Fund".

The ALUMNI SUBJECT AWARDS are given to students who may qualify for a specific achievement. These awards are often created by family members or classes to honor a graduate or teacher. The alumni association combines the funds of many of these awards into appropriate savings investments for growth and distribution. Currently we have 16 of these types of awards to maintain.

The ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS are given by the Shamokin and Coal Township Alumni Associations to high school students by placement testing. While exact amounts and quantity of scholarships may change, in 2020 we awarded 16 students scholarships ranging from \$2,000 to \$4,000 per year for 4 years. Your education fund contributions help fund this impressive program.

### WALTER E. FIDLER, JR.

Walter E. Fidler, Jr., passed away on March 11, 2020 at the age of 98. Walter was a proud member of the Shamokin High School Class of 1939. Following graduation, he entered the family business, W.E. Fidler and Sons, as a painter and paperhanger. Upon his retirement

from the painting business, Walter became the foreman for the Shamokin City Street Department. Walter served in the United States Army from 1942 until his discharge as a tech sergeant in 1946. His service was with the infantry in France and Germany under General George Patton.

Walter became president of the Shamokin Area High School Alumni Association in 1965. During his time with the association, he served as chairman of the program committee and in many other capacities. He was an elected member of the Shamokin Area School Board for 18 years, holding all of the offices at one time or another, but most notably as president of the board during the construction of the present high school. In addition, he served as the chairman, secretary and treasurer of the Northumberland County Vo-Tech Board.



Walter was a life member of the Calvary Bible Fellowship Church, where he served as an elder. Additionally, he was a Blue Lodge member of the Fraternal Order of Free and Accepted Masons, the American Legion and the Liberty Hose Fire Company.

Attorney Myron M. Moskowitz passed away on Friday September 13, 2019 at the age of 93. A graduate

of the Class of 1942, he went on to further his education at the University of Pennsylvania Law School.

Myron served in the United States Army during World War II, as a member of the First Cavalry in the Pacific. He returned to Shamokin and opened his law office in 1951, continuing to practice law into his 90's.

Attorney Moskowitz was deeply involved with the Shamokin Area High School Alumni Association for many years, serving as president in 1990. Additionally, he served on the Awards Committee and was a member of the Education Fund at the time of his passing.
