


The Senior Class led the Alumni Association in singing of the Alma Mater. The Alma Mater was accompanied by Mary Anne Brennan Stump '00.

also continue to participate in dual enrollment courses at Bloomsburg University, Luzerne County Community College, and Lackawanna College. As a final note, we have embraced the world of cyber education by housing our very own. Spear Virtual Learning Academy is becoming a highlight of our district. Students now have the opportunity to learn virtually from the Shamokin Area School District. We are extremely proud of this style of learning offered by the district.

Musically, our entire music department is happy to be back to full in-person performances. Mr. Nelson Rodriguez-Parada was named our new orchestra director and has been amazing for our school and students. We are very fortunate to have him. Eleven students participated in PMEA district festivals for band orchestra and chorus, and Shamokin Area served as the host site for this year's PMEA District 8 Orchestra festival. Two students are advancing to the PMEA regional level. The competition marching band had a successful season. The modern music club and Garage Band class continue to grow and build student interest in performing and writing pop/rock music. Lastly, the 2022 musical, "The Little Mermaid" was performed on April 1 and 2. We hope you were able to catch this outstanding production produced by our students and music staff.

In the area of athletics, both our team and individual athletes continue to work hard to excel in their sport. Girls Basketball, Boys Basketball, Softball, Girls Soccer, Football, and Girls Golf all qualified for the PIAA District Championships. Boys basketball was PHAC Division 1 Co-Champion. Softball had a 1st and 2nd team all-state selection. Cross Country and Track each had a state qualifier. We had a male and female soccer player each score their 50th goals. The Bridy-Ruane Field was dedicated by Joe Bridy, class of '94, and members of the Bridy and Ruane families earlier this year. We also brought back golf for the first time since 2014.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank the Shamokin Area High School Alumni Association for your support. I recognize the hard work and effort put forth by the association each year and I commend you for your generosity to the school district and to our students through the alumni scholarships and other donations. It is greatly appreciated.
