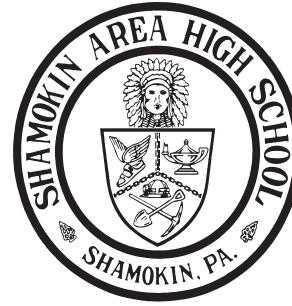

139th Annual Reunion

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Irving Berlin's song "God Bless America" was sung by all attending with Mary Anne Brennan Stump '00 as the accompanist.

Erik Anderson '97—President of the Alumni Association—provided the banquet introductions. A delicious meal was provided by Masser's Catering. After dessert, the business meeting started with a silent prayer in memory of deceased members.
