Dear Alumni,

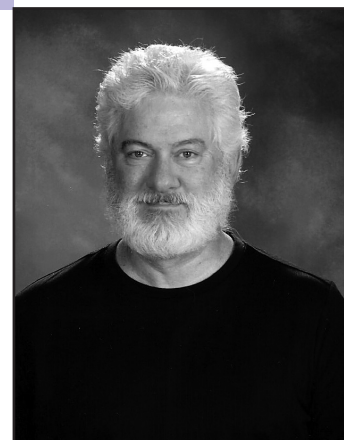

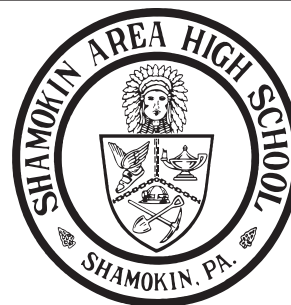
