## **Poster Projects**

<u>Directions:</u> Using your account on postermywall.com, please create a <u>"New Design"</u> <u>"Poster"</u> about <u>Studying</u>. This is not an essay but more like an <u>"infographic"</u>. Please look up the term if you do not know what it means to be given examples.

**Background/Images:** You do not necessarily need an image as a background. You could use colors. If you use a photo as the background, you must make sure the viewer can still see the text.

**Sources:** At the bottom, list the sources (websites) you used for your information. Make sure they are credible (rule of thumb: .org, .gov, or ASK any teacher).
