<u>Page Ideas;</u>

- <u>Student Work</u> Include some of your work that you have completed in school such as essays, art projects, technology projects, and presentations. Be proud of yourself and show others!
- <u>Pictures</u> Some students in the past have included a photo gallery of their interests. Some have also create a MEME page of their favorite (AND SCHOOL APPROPRIATE) memes. Be creative.
- <u>Videos</u> This may be difficult in school, but you may want to include some of your favorite youtube videos. Perhaps just 3–5.
- <u>Music</u> Some students had included their favorite artists with a playlist or videos of their favorite clean songs.
- <u>Games</u> Some students even included a page on their website devoted to their favorite school games. You can actually link/embed certain games to be played directly from your website.

**These are just ideas and you do not need to include any/all. Take a look at what some others are doing for your own ideas
