MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS  
BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS COMMITTEE**

September 15, 2020

The Shamokin Area School Board's Buildings and Grounds Committee met on Tuesday, September 15, 2020, in the board conference room. Mr. Kashner called the meeting to order at 11:00 am. In attendance were Jeffrey Kashner, Chairman, and Board President Brian Persing.

Others in attendance included staff members Chris J. Venna, Superintendent; Todd Hockenbroch, Middle/High School Principal; David Petrovich, Supervisor of Facilities & Maintenance; and Rick Kashner, Athletic Director.

Mr. Petrovich reports everything is good. They are treading in new waters this year, but everyone is stepping up. Preventive maintenance is catching up, filters are being changed every 3 months due to the pandemic and the misting machines are working out great.

Mr. Petrovich raised the need of winterizing the annex building. There are some different options and he is trying to figure out the best way. He will start gathering prices to compare. Decisions should be made soon. It will be revisited at the next meeting.

Jeff Kashner asked about a custodian at the Vo-Tech for Pre-K Counts. Dave stated that the part-time worker who is usually assigned to locker rooms and the pool area, which are not being used right now, is up there. He also has it posted for another part-time position to be hired.

He also questioned if there were any services we can go out for pricing to save money. He didn't know but did share the fine print should be checked on the contracts by our solicitor because he thinks there are timing limits.
